- Increase in SOS Data – I receive useful feedback in my work, this school encourages coaching and mentoring activities, I have access to quality professional development.
- Increase in student attendance data (88% - 90%)
- Increase English LOA to 94% A-C 63% A-B
- Increase Mathematics LOA to 96.6% A-C 70% A-B
- Increase Reading – ave. 2 PM per term, 1 Probe per term. Spelling – ave. 5 total points per term for the 5 selected Marker Students (see separate documents).

Our initiatives include

- Dive deep alongside teachers into unit plans:
 - to align 6Cs to general capabilities
 - strengthen precision in pedagogy
 - enhance capabilities of staff to identify and adopt the opportunities to promote inquiry learning within the curriculum unit using the P-6 Curriculum Model (ensuring validity and reliability of standards).
 - ensure a shared understanding the Australian Curriculum and achievement standards
 - develop capabilities of all staff to be assessment literate learners.
- Strengthen and refine the crafting of Deep Learning pedagogical practices within units of work and aligned to the Scenic Rim and Hinterland proposed signature practices tool kit.
- Review, refine and prioritise Case Management Meeting and Inclusion/ Enrichment timetabling to include rigorous development of staff capabilities in assessment as well as analysis of all data collected.
- Develop inclusion, enrichment and support timetables that utilise staff capabilities and are data driven for students' targeted learning plans.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Actively engage in the Lead Learning Collaborative Cohort 4 including TRS for teaching staff to attend. - **\$4500**
- TRS for staff planning days to ensure co-planning and co-teaching - **\$9324**
- Actively engage and lead the Scenic Rim and Hinterland Deep Learning Network including TRS, student transport and resources, leadership opportunities for students - **\$2093**
